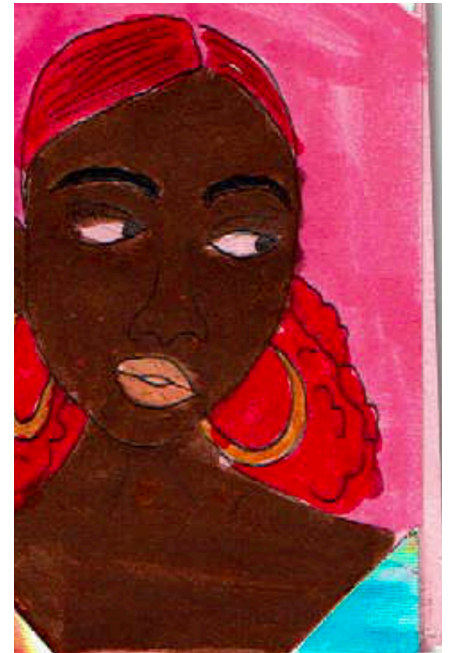
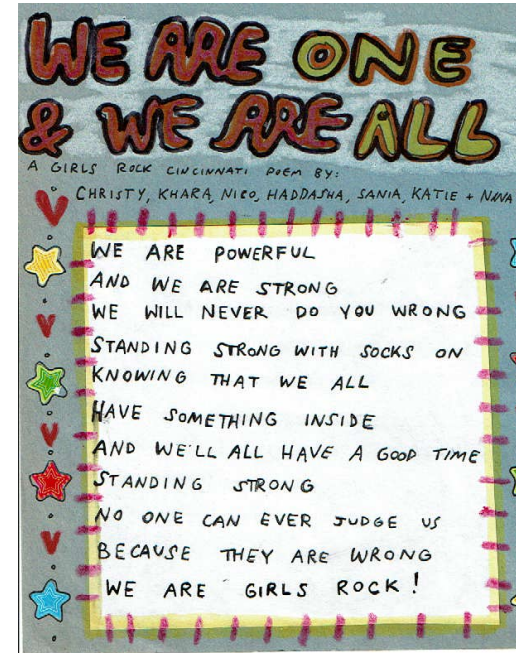

We had **15** campers and **33** volunteers.



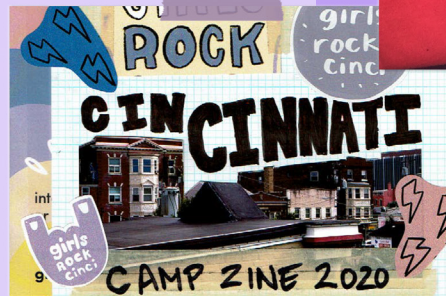
Tuition was entirely **free!**
